THIS SUNDAY at 2PM: College Grove Christmas Parade




The College Grove



In January of 2023 the Riverside Fellowship church board set up an interest-bearing Money Market account with an initial balance of \$175,000. These funds were transferred from our regular checking account and do not affect our regular monthly obligations.

The purpose of this fund is to address future needs as we move towards a more permanent meeting location. Now that we have moved to Page Middle School, the church board is actively searching for a new permanent meeting space that will allow us to have a more flexible worship site that allows for future growth. The Future Fund will give us the starting capital to rent, lease or buy a space that will accommodate our growth.

While we have not established a formal capital campaign to generate additional funds for this account, we are taking donations that will be earmarked for these future expenses.
